WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Fairmount are authorized to protect the public health and adopt appropriate police regulations, and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Fairmount wish to regulate times of the day minors may be on public property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the president and the Board of Trustees, as follows:

## Section1:

- A. It is unlawful for a person 17 years of age or younger, to be present at or upon any public assembly, building, place, street or highway at the following times, unless accompanied and supervised by a parent, legal guardian or other responsible companion at least 18 years of age approved by a parent or legal guardian, unless engaged in a business or occupation, or returning from or going to a school event (ex. sports, fieldtrip, dance) which the laws of the State of Illinois authorize a person 17 years of age or less to perform:
  - 1. From September 1 through May 31<sup>st</sup>, between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M, 7 days per week.
  - 2. From June 1 through August 31<sup>st</sup>, between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 a.m., 7 days per week.
- B. Penalty: Punishment and fines for violation of the above listed curfew shall be as follows:
  - 1. A first time violator shall receive a written warning and be returned home.
  - 2. A second time violator shall be liable for \$100 fine.
  - 3. For each additional violation, the violator shall be fined an additional \$200 fine. (ex. third offense \$ 200 fine, fourth offense \$200 fine)
  - 4. Any person incurring a fine shall be held at the Public Safety Building in Danville, Illinois for parental or guardian pick up.

Section 2: This Ordinance, shall be implemented immediately and shall be in force and in effect after its passage and approval.

Section 3: With the passage of this ordinance all previous curfew designated ordinances are hereby repealed.
